Dear Friends and Supporters,

Welcome to our 2016 combined Summer/Autumn newsletter, which from now on will replace separate issues for these seasons.

2015 saw Save-A-Dog Scheme save the lives of 600 companion animals, comprising 358 dogs and 242 cats. SADS delivered a save rate of 98.6% for dogs and 96.3% for cats. Sadly there was a small number of both dogs and cats, that, despite our best efforts, could not responsibly be rehomed.

The majority of the dogs came from country pounds and the majority of the cats from the Stonnington and Boroondara areas.

Most of the dogs needed veterinary treatment, often major veterinary work, in addition to the routine requirements of vaccination, desexing, microchipping, worming and defleaing.

The redevelopment of the SADS owned Yarrambat property to be a fully compliant animal shelter has survived the many challenges of modern planning intricacies and is poised to start with the first stage of acoustic improvements..

Many of the animals saved by SADS would not have had a chance of survival elsewhere as we have illustrated with the accompanying story of the puppies with mange.

To save these animals and honour its commitment to helping these dogs and cats SADS requires a lot of resources, so please....we do the work you believe in but we need your continuing help to be able to do it.

"Peter" & "Paul"

"Peter" and "Paul" came to Save-A-Dog Scheme about 5 weeks ago at approx 3 months old. The were suffering from severe and advanced mange and had been pushed under the fence at a building site in Stonnington. The guess is that they are mastiff x's.

Unfortunately the mange was discovered to be sarcoptic mange which is contagious until treated and required strict quarantine and "barrier nursing" procedures during the acute stage. It is very rare to come across Sarcoptic mange nowadays in Australia although many of the dogs which SADS takes, especially from country pounds, are diagnosed with the non contagious and more easily handled demodectic mange. Save-A-Dog Scheme (SADS) was established in 1985 to offer a humane alternative to the killing of unwanted dogs, especially dogs of good temperament, that would otherwise be destroyed at pounds and shelters.

SADS is an incorporated, non-profit, community based organisation controlled and operated by volunteers with the help of paid staff. It operates as a registered animal shelter and combines this with foster care in the community. Each dog is desexed, vaccinated, wormed, microchipped, vet checked and temperament assessed prior to adoption.

SADS has a no kill philosophy and believes that the dichotomy of a dog being "Mans Best Friend" on the one hand and an unwanted article for destruction on the other is

totally unacceptable. SADS is a "coal-face" organisation, which saves hundreds of dogs each year and which seeks, by example, to provide a better way of treating non-human animals.

Save-A-Dog Scheme relies on donations for its continuing existence and does not receive any government funding. Donations to Save-A-Dog Scheme are now tax deductible and help with the general care of the dogs and the maintenance of the organisation.

The greatest expense is for veterinary treatment for the dogs, which includes the care of sick and injured dogs. These dogs are nursed back to health rather than being destroyed as they may be elsewhere.


